On behalf of *DENTROICA KIRTLANDII* ~  
Kirtland Warbler ~ passerines in need of sanctuary.  
Currently overwintering in the Bahamas,  
Turks and Caicos handling Fall migration overflow.  
Applicants will have at least 160 acres of *PINUS BANKSIANA*.  
Jack Pine forest must be available for Spring migration.  
Documented Cowbirds in the vicinity are considered illegals;  
habitat manager must be able to handle evictions,  
have relocation plan in order.  
Will have blueberries in your understory. Ship sample.  
Send photos of young trees only (4-20 years).  
Aged Jack's need not apply.  
Repeat, Aged Jack's need not apply.  
Mandatory fungi check for sweet fern blister rust.  
Please include botanist's clearance.  
History of vertical orange cankers or *Scleroderris*  
will lead to evil Shakespearean citations.  
Knowledge of weeviling beneficial.  
Talent for drowning larvae in pitch viewed favorably.  
Consorting with Canadians  
who are involved with Hydro pole logging  
is expressly forbidden.  
Successful applicant will offer landscape biomass  
that burns, floods or can be thinned by wind.  
Preferred accommodation is a medley of ground cover duff:  
pine needle, bark strip, grass and vegetable fiber.  
Please supply translations of the following:  
chip chip chip too too weet weet,  
and flip-lip-lip-lip-tip-tip-CHIDIP.  
Confession of Pyrophobia will cause your application to be rejected.  
Applicants involved in seedling propagation will be short-listed.  
Committee work with relics or ghost species  
an unfortunate necessity.
